Discussion of past issues.

- 1. People just want to help during disasters. Do drills that practice skills. Drills with other agencies.
- 2. Bring in fresh new ideas from new members. Train with other CERT groups.
- 3. We asked people to do more than self-care, but they may have joined just for that.
- 4. Try holding more active events and less business meetings.
- 5. Too much repetition in CERT classes tends to be boring. Need more activities.
- 6. Have each county CERT hold a drill and invite other counties so we get more than one per year.
- 7. More hands-on training.
- 8. Need to do activities with combined CAER groups.
- 9. Training expectations make it more fun, leave out repetition, leave out unnecessary sections like earthquakes.
- 10. CAER do training for all groups together.
- 11. Let others train and badged to do specific tasks like damage assessment and sheltering. Create this new badged group. Develop skill sets that are needed.
- 12. Have one meeting bimonthly (even months 3rd Wednesday). Do a short 15-minute business meeting followed by training.
- 13. How do we organize CERT?
 - a. Rotate leaders of activities.
 - b. Have a paid person to organize like Shirley Woodfill did.
- 14. Tom Karnaskaus Need separate CERT meetings but participate in CAER meetings. Combine business meeting and training. We are functioning like a club.
- 15. Bonnie Johnson Trinity Lutheran Church wants to hold the next CERT Class at their church.
- 16. Iris Johnson We need to order manuals. We have none. Last three classes FEMA Pub shipped none to us from our orders to them. Had to manually print our own.
- 17. June meeting discussion At first is was going to be about how to organize CERT and set a calendar of events for the year. Now it is going to be a 15-minute business meeting followed by search & rescue training for 45 minutes. Jerry Ibberson volunteered to lead this meeting. We may include refreshments. Iris Johnson, Barb Ruhter & Tom Karnaskaus volunteered to assist Jerry. The four will meet at 6:00pm May 15th before the CAER meeting. Iris will send the other 3 a reminder on the 14th.
- 18. Tom asked everyone if they were satisfied with the meeting. Iris and Jerry were not.
