Old Business

- 2. Covid Vaccinations Public Health is doing drive thru shot clinics at the public works building on Wednesdays from 10:30 am to 4:30 pm. They need CERT volunteers to help. There are 2 3hour shifts each Wednesday.

New Business

1. Sheltering

- a. After a shelter closes CERT volunteers will inventory the shelter kits to resupply and reorganize.
- b. On Jan 8th 9am at the firehall Iris Johnson, Bob Beier, Kirsten Sailer, and Sherry Segal are going to inventory the armory shelter kit. Iris Johnson to share the outcome with Jerry Ibberson for his input. The purpose is to agree on what the kits should have in them versus what is there before Tom Karnauskas orders supplies for the new shelter kits.
- c. We spent a little time on reviewing the shelter training but due to a deadline on submitting to Community Ed Spring catalog we tabled the review until a later date.
 - The group decided that HIPPA training be required for all working in registration along with possessing a current county badge. The training will be a written instruction that volunteers read and take a short test then submit to Tom Karnauskas.
 - ii. It is acceptable to ask for a personal ID.
 - iii. Kristen Sailer suggested purchasing the wrist bands with numbers on them thus eliminating the need for the numbered cards.
 - iv. We will put registration forms on the bus so that people can fill out the form prior to arrival at the shelter.
