

Requesting Direct State Assistance



Jurisdiction Having Authority (JHA)

- When local resources, vendors, and mutual aid has become exhausted; the requesting JHA submits a resource request to their respective jurisdictional emergency management (EM) agency. (County, Tribe, City of the First-Class)

Jurisdictional Emergency Management

- Local EM will review, vet, and fill request if possible. If unable to fill through local mutual aid/vendors, and state assistance is required, the local EM will submit request to State Emergency Operation Center (SEOC) via MN Duty Officer and WebEOC.

State Emergency Operation Center (SEOC)

- The State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC) will determine if the request constitutes an unmet need - in that the requesting jurisdiction as exhausted all local options.
- **The SEOC will support by:**
 - directing the request to the appropriate state agency identified in the Minnesota Emergency Operations Plan (MEOP) and by Governor's Executive Order 19-22;
 - by providing sourcing options and vendor information as requested;
 - by requesting interstate mutual aid through EMAC, NEMAC, or Direct Federal Support;
 - by direct purchase and distribution of supplies only when/if directed to do so by the Governor's Authorized Representative (GAR) and/or the State Incident Manager (SIM).
